### A Special Message From Pastor Mike Hoppe

If we could bottle up "church" into pill form and somehow sell it to Mobile county residents, we could make millions!

A Harvard study revealed that being active in church provided "numerous aspects of human flourishing." Which of the following benefits in this study sounds best to you...greater happiness in life, improved mental health, greater feeling of purpose, and deeper social relationships compared to those who did not attend any church regularly? It also discovered that active church-goers were less likely to be engaged in drug or alcohol abuse, and they found that respondents were 30%-50% less likely to divorce!

I have two thoughts after reading this study. First, I wonder if plummeting nationwide church attendance might be one factor in the surge of nationwide mental health struggles. Second, I wonder, how all of us do our part to get more people connected to church!

Being active in church provides powerful health benefits because the gospel message of Jesus Christ provides freedom and purpose. Further, a church family is a powerful support system in times of need, and serving at church provides us a deeply fulfilling sense of serving something higher than ourselves.

Jesus is changing lives everywhere, including right here at Stillwater. He is freeing people from addiction, helping people experience forgiveness, and saving marriages. Hungry people are being fed and sick people are receiving prayer. Read just one testimony, below, from a Stillwater member whose life has changed:

"When I started going to Stillwater, I was leaving an emotionally and physically abusive relationship and felt utterly alone. For the first time in my forty-four years, the love and support of my Stillwater church family helped me discover my worth in God's love and the truth that I am not wasted space. It feels good to have people in my corner. I don't know how I would have made it without my church being there for me. Stillwater is my home, and words cannot express the gratitude in my heart." -LeeAnnea Lumley


