A Special Message From Pastor Mike Hoppe

One question I always ask new people in our Discover Stillwater class is "If you had all the money in the world and never had to work again, what type of serving role would excite you? How would you love spending your free time to make a difference in the world?"

Everyone has an answer to this question. For example, we currently have a billionaire president who chose to serve in political office without pay. For me personally, running *for* office would never be my first choice - I might run *away* from office instead! That's why I'm thankful for people who feel called to serve in elected positions.

In the church, God's calling often intersects with our passions. Do you know where your passion aligns with God's calling for you? Identifying this intersection can help you find joy and purpose in serving.

One way to discover this is by considering what kind of serving role energizes you instead of draining you. What excites you enough to get out of bed in the morning? Some people love making BBQ, teaching children, doing maintenance on God's house, cooking for large groups, or showing hospitality. Some are passionate about being on stage, while others prefer behind the scenes. Some love organizing teams, preparing lessons, or using their hands to build or repair. What kind of service makes your heart sing?

If you're unsure, here are some practical steps to help you sense how God might be calling you to serve at Stillwater:

- 1. Listen Prayerfully to Announcements: Our weekly e-newsletter and Sunday announcements highlight opportunities to connect with what God is doing throughout the week. Instead of zoning out, listen with a prayerful heart. God might be prompting you to try something new.
- **2. Explore the Serving Opportunities Sheet:** In the lobby, you'll find a serving opportunities sheet that lists many ways to get involved. Take a copy home, review it prayerfully, and consider how you might contribute.
- **3. Attend Discover Stillwater**: This four-week class is designed to help new people at Stillwater connect in meaningful ways beyond Sunday morning worship. It's a great place to discover where your gifts can best be used.

Serving not only makes a difference in the lives of others but also brings joy and fulfillment to the one who serves. Would you take a moment to pray about one new way God might be calling you to serve? Together, we can make an incredible impact for God's kingdom!
