A Special Message from Pastor Mike Hoppe

Resurrection

Easter is the celebration of what Jesus gave us through His resurrection. It is the ultimate declaration that death does not have the final say. The cross and the tomb, once symbols of suffering and loss, became empty and transformed by Christ's victory over sin and death. Jesus was raised with His body into heaven, where He reigns even now. In doing so, He shattered the plans of evil, broke the power of death, and opened the way for us to follow Him into eternal life.

In a sense, Jesus poked a hole in the floor of heaven for us, offering a path where there was none. He spoke of a "narrow way" (Matthew 7:14), a road that leads to life for all who trust in Him. But while many have heard the Easter story, far too few have personally surrendered their own path to Jesus. Knowing *about* the resurrection is one thing - choosing to walk in its power is another.

That's why Easter is such an important time for us as a church. God longs for all people to know and trust Jesus, and He calls us to share this life-changing message. This is why we invite guests, neighbors, and friends to celebrate Easter with us - not just to hear a story, but to encounter the risen Christ and receive the new life He offers.

But Easter isn't just about what Jesus *adds* to our lives - it's also about what He frees us from. In our pursuit of faith, we often think about what we need to do more: more faith, more discipline, more good works. But sometimes, the key to spiritual renewal isn't in adding more - it's in *removing* what doesn't belong.

Just as the empty tomb signified freedom from death, we, too, are called to let go of anything that keeps us from fully experiencing Christ's resurrection power. Are we carrying burdens that Jesus has already lifted? Are we clinging to fears, distractions, or old habits that keep us from walking in His abundant life?

This Easter, what might God be calling you to leave behind?

May we step into the fullness of life that Jesus offers, unburdened and free, following the path He has made for us - all the way to eternity.
