## A Special Message from Pastor Tony Barnes

May is a Time for Reflection and Renewal

As May 2025 approaches, I am filled with excitement and awe at what God has been doing. I have now had the honor of serving as your associate pastor for two years and have loved every minute. I have watched as God has been moving in each and every one of you and in this church we call Stillwater. This time of year, for me, has caused a time of great reflection.

I had the pleasure of serving at the last Men's Emmaus Walk and had to prepare for a talk on the Means of Grace. One of the points of that talk is ordination. Many of you know that I will be ordained on May 5, 2025, at our Annual Conference in Montgomery. As I was writing about what that would mean for me and what it has taken to get there, I began to think of that moment in time when I finally said yes to God's call for pastoral ministry. I remember the exact moment, because it was during my Emmaus Walk on that Sunday afternoon that I told God that he could stop chasing because I was tired of running. I wanted to know that exact day for my talk to these new Emmaus men. I pulled out my blue book that tells all the particulars of a walk, and I was completely shocked to see that my walk was May 3-5, 2019. That means that my decision to answer that call was May 5, 2019, and my ordination is May 5, 2025. With God, there are no coincidences, only affirmations, that you are on the right path.

May is an exciting time. Spring comes and life seems to be renewed. This is also a time that our graduates set out on new adventures. I have two girls at home that are preparing to head off to college. We have others in our church as well. Some are heading off to college, and some are graduating and preparing to start their careers. As they set off on this new chapter of life, it is my prayer that they understand that you don't graduate from the church. Your relationship with God is a lifelong learning adventure that will take you to places you never imagined. So, as you pack away those school uniforms for the last time, hold fast to God's Word and listen for his calling on your life.

Many Methodists around the world have listened to that calling in their faith journey. It was only two Mays ago that we saw the birth of our new denomination, the Global Methodist Church. Through that new birth we have seen a resurgence of the Holy Spirit as it has revitalized our faith. Everything seems to be in bloom during this time of year.

As you are enjoying this May, I pray that you open your hearts and minds to the glories that God wants to show you. I pray that you will take the time to stop and listen and then act on that call, whatever it may be. Be open to new opportunities, new life and new growth.



## **Missions Update**

This month the Missions Committee is highlighting the Stillwater Food Pantry! The Food Pantry has been serving the North Mobile County area for years. In 2020, the need grew tremendously and God has been paving the way for us to continue serving. In 2024 alone, an accumulated 5,486 households were served. This was over 136 tons of food distributed that cost over \$31,000. This has been made possible through the help of 59 active volunteers! More volunteers are always needed and welcomed. The following is a list of volunteer opportunities in the Stillwater Food Pantry:

**UNLOADING FOOD TRUCK:** Days vary. Receive 1-2 food trucks per month. Arrival time is usually in the mornings.

**BAGGING FOOD BAGS:** Thursday, every other week. Time: 3:00pm-5:30pm

**FOOD DISTRIBUTION:** Mondays. Time: 8:30am-11:15am

**PRODUCE DISTRIBUTION:** Fridays, on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Friday each month. Time: 10:00am-1:15pm. Light lunch is usually provided on Produce Day.
