
Kids Korner

Campus Project Update

We want you to be aware of ongoing upgrades on our campus. Thank you for your faithful giving that makes these projects happen:



- Roofing: Our flat roof has been failing. Thankfully, it is still under warranty and the original installers are replacing the roof. In the meantime, we are enduring drips and fixing ceiling tiles.
- Van: The church van interior became wet and, as a result, became covered in mold. We had it professionally cleaned and hope it can be salvaged. We currently have \$6,500 in our new bus fund towards the eventual dream of purchasing a new, small bus.
- New Air Conditioner: The air conditioner in the Boy Scout building had to be replaced at a cost of \$6,500.

This summer, Stillwater has been partnering with Saraland Schools to provide food for approximately 30 students. These students were identified by counselors as having the most severe need for food while out of school. Thanks to our Food Pantry volunteers for coordinating this important ministry.
