Message from Pastor Mike Hoppe

The Most Desired Spiritual Gift

Can you answer this Bible trivia question: According to Paul in the New Testament, which gift of the Spirit should Christians desire the most? Is it teaching? Preaching? Evangelism? Or maybe baking an

amazing pound cake like Mary Cleveland? (Now that's a special gift!)

All of these are wonderful and important, but Paul points to one spiritual gift above the rest. He writes, "Eagerly desire the gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy" (1 Corinthians 14:1).

Prophecy is one of the Holy Spirit's most powerful gifts and yet, one of the least understood.

One more trivia question: What are the three key characteristics of New Testament prophecy? Paul explains, "The one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging, and comfort" (1 Corinthians 14:3). You can remember these three words with the simple acronym SEC: Prophecy Strengthens, Encourages, and Comforts.

The Father speaks to his people so they can know their God-given value, identity, and worth in his Kingdom. Prophecy involves God communicating with two people, one who gives the prophetic word and the other who receives it. Leaders with this spiritual gift within the early church "said much to encourage and strengthen the believers" (Acts 15:32). Their Spirit-inspired words built up the community and kept faith strong through difficult times.

Today, this gift is just as vital as it was then, and maybe even more so. We live in a world filled with voices that tear down, discourage, and distress. But prophetic words, inspired by the Holy Spirit, have the power to do the opposite. They build up, uplift, and bring peace.

So, I encourage you to **eagerly desire the gift of prophecy**. Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you and use you to strengthen, encourage, and comfort others. Your words, spoken under His direction, can defeat the enemy's lies and empower God's people for greater works.

May our Stillwater family become a place overflowing with prophetic grace—where every believer strengthens, encourages, and comforts one another in the love and power of the Spirit.

November Sermon Series "Thessalonians: Faith in Uncertain Times"



Backpack Ministry


Our Backpack Ministry feeds hungry students at all four of the Saraland schools. We need your help to pack bags, deliver bags on Fridays, and to donate food items throughout the school year.

Sign-up sheets for packing bags and delivering bags are available at the Welcome Desk in the church lobby.

Food items needed include ravioli, spaghetti-o's, soup, pop tarts, Vienna sausage, canned chicken, canned tuna, fruit cups, pudding cups, jerky sticks, small boxes of raisins, small packages of cookies, cheese crackers, breakfast bars, Ramen Noodles, instant grits and oatmeal packets, macaroni and cheese cups, and juice boxes. No items with peanut butter are needed due to allergies. Donated items can be dropped off in the lobby at our missions table. Thank you for serving students who require food assistance on the weekends.
