A Special Message from Pastor Tony Barnes Joyful Noise

There is something sacred about the sounds of Advent. Long before the Christmas lights glow or the candles are lit, the season begins with a stirring in the heart—an invitation to lift our eyes, open our mouths, and join the ancient song of God's people. This year at Stillwater, our Advent theme, "Joyful Noise," reminds us that praise is not merely something we offer to God; it is something God uses to reshape us from the inside out.

The story begins in a quiet house in Judea where Zechariah, who had spent months in silence, suddenly found his voice again. After four hundred years without a recorded prophetic word, heaven broke the silence—not with thunder, but with praise. Luke tells us that when Zechariah confirmed the name of his newborn son, "his mouth was opened... and he began to speak, praising God." (Luke 1:64) It's no small thing that the return of his voice was marked not by complaint or explanation but by worship.

In that moment, praise changed the atmosphere. A home that had known doubt and waiting was filled with the sound of faith. Zechariah's story invites us to consider the power of our own praise—how our words can shift discouragement into hope, fear into trust, and silence into joyful expectation. Advent begins with a mouth filled with praise.

But the story continues in the heart of a young woman from Nazareth. When Mary received the angel's message, her world turned upside down. Yet instead of collapsing under the weight of uncertainty, she responded with a song—a soul-deep proclamation of God's goodness. Her Magnificat is more than poetry; it is the testimony of a heart being healed even as it surrenders.

Mary teaches us that praise begins inner healing. When our souls magnify the Lord, we loosen our grip on anxiety and make room for God's renewing strength. Advent invites us into that same kind of soul-filled worship—quiet, honest, and transformative.

Then, on an ordinary night in Bethlehem's fields, heaven's praise spilled onto the earth. A multitude of angels appeared, lifting their voices in a chorus that lit up the sky. It was not a private moment; it was communal worship. The shepherds heard the sound not as a solitary melody but as a swelling harmony of heaven.

This reminds us of the beautiful truth that we are strengthened when we praise God together. Congregational singing is more than tradition—it is a gift. When voices blend in worship, burdens lighten, hearts come together, and the faith of one encourages the faith of another. Advent calls us back into that shared song, where we discover again that we are not alone.

Finally, as we approach Christmas Eve, the song widens beyond Judea, Nazareth, or Bethlehem. Scripture gives us a glimpse of a future gathering—a multitude from every nation, tribe, and language standing before the throne of God, crying out with unified praise. This is where the story is heading.

On that holy night, when we lift our voices in worship, we join a song that spans centuries and crosses continents. The birth of Jesus was never meant for one people alone; it is God's gift to the whole world. Our Christmas Eve worship becomes a small echo of that great, coming chorus of all nations.

So, this Advent, as candles are lifted, we join together as one voice, and the story unfolds once again, may our mouths be filled with praise, our souls renewed with joy, our community strengthened in worship, and our hearts awakened to God's mission.

May we, together, make a joyful noise that honors the Savior who has come—and who will one day gather all creation into His everlasting song.




Men's Breakfast, Dec. 7


Director of Contemporary Worship

Food Pantry Update

November was a challenging month for the Food Pantry. The Food Pantry had regular distributions and did a community-wide distribution. With the government shutdown, recipients of food stamps did not receive food stamps. We signed up about 60 new neighbors in November, mostly due to no food stamps. The Food Pantry was blessed to hand out 140 turkeys to our neighbors for Thanksgiving.



In just November, the Food Pantry distributed over 55,272 pounds, or 27.6 tons, of food. We served 759 households, which equaled 2,281 individuals.

I want to give a huge THANK YOU to all of the wonderful volunteers working in the Food Pantry. Thank you for the monetary donations, the prayers, and patience with the Food Pantry.

May we give God all the Glory for His many blessings on this ministry.

Food items needed include ravioli, spaghetti-o's, soup, pop tarts, Vienna sausage, canned chicken, canned tuna, fruit cups, pudding cups, jerky sticks, small boxes of raisins, small packages of cookies, cheese crackers, breakfast bars, Ramen Noodles, instant grits and oatmeal packets, macaroni and cheese cups, and juice boxes. No items with peanut butter are needed due to allergies. Donated items can be dropped off in the lobby at our missions table. Thank you for serving students who require food assistance on the weekends.
